Professionals who want to certify their technical knowledge in basic installation, operation and troubleshooting for Linux operating systems should consider this certification. The skills and knowledge measured by this examination were developed with global input to assure accuracy, validity and reliability. Earning the CompTIA Linux+ designation means that the candidate can explain fundamental open source resources/licenses, demonstrate knowledge of user administration, understand file permissions/software configurations and manage local storage devices and network protocols.Because Linux, by its nature, is vendor-independent, there was a strong need in the industry for a basic, comprehensive Linux certification. Becoming CompTIA Linux+ certified gives an individual a recognized industry credential that offers proof of knowledge and expertise in Linux technologies. This certification also provides a path to a variety of fulfilling and challenging Linux-related careers.

What are unscored items?

Sometimes questions that do not count toward exam results are included in CompTIA exams. These exam questions (or "items") are included in the test, but are not scored. These questions have no impact on whether a candidate passes or fails the exam. Occasionally these questions may even test a topic area that is not part of the exam objectives, and therefore is not covered in any of the training materials. Unscored items are generally seeded on an exam to allow for the collection of preliminary psychometric data. Candidates are notified in pre-exam documentation at the exam testing center when unscored items are included in an exam.

Why were there questions on the exam that covered technologies or concepts not included in the objectives or in my CAQC training materials?

It is most likely that these questions are "unscored items." Sometimes questions that do not count toward exam results are included in CompTIA exams. These exam questions (or "items") are included in the test, but are not scored. These questions have no impact on whether a candidate passes or fails the exam. Occasionally these questions may even test a topic area that is not part of the exam objectives, and therefore is not covered in any of the training materials. Unscored items are generally seeded on an exam to allow for the collection of preliminary psychometric data. Candidates are notified in pre-exam documentation at the exam testing center when unscored items are included in an exam.

What format is the CompTIA Linux+ exam in?

The CompTIA Linux+ exam is in a conventional format consisting of 94 identification and situational multiple-choice questions.

What languages is the CompTIA Linux+ exam available in?

The CompTIA Linux+ exam is available in English, German and Japanese.

How many questions are on the CompTIA Linux+ exam?

There are 94 questions on the CompTIA Linux+ exam.

How much time is allowed to complete the CompTIA Linux+ exam?

You are allowed 90 minutes to complete the CompTIA Linux+ exam.

What is the minimum score required to pass the CompTIA Linux+ exam?

The CompTIA Linux+ exam is graded on a scale of 100 - 900. The minimum passing score is 655.

What is the exam code for the CompTIA Linux+ test?

The exam code for the CompTIA Linux+ test is XK0-001.

Are there any prerequisites necessary for the CompTIA Linux+ certification?

There are no prerequisites for the CompTIA Linux+ exam. However, it is recommended that you have CompTIA A+ and Network+ certifications or equivalent knowledge.

No. To maintain the quality and integrity of the certification, exams must remain secure at all times and no questions or answers are ever released under any circumstances.

If I have a disability can accommodations be made for me so I can take my exam?

It is the policy of CompTIA to make reasonable accommodations for US residents with disabilities. If you need special accommodations, contact your testing center 30 days before scheduling your exam and have your disability documentation available.

What other certifications are available?

CompTIA currently offers eleven vendor-neutral certifications that validate specific skill

sets and areas of knowledge. These include CompTIA A+, Network+, Server+, CDIA+, e-Biz+, Project+, I-Net+, Linux+, HTI+, Security+ and CTT+.

If I fail my exam, do I have to pay to retake it?

Yes, you have to pay the fee every time you take the test. Please see the <u>CompTIA</u> Candidate Retake policy for additional information.

Will I ever need to renew my certification?

No, CompTIA certifications are lifetime certifications.

How do I get a replacement certificate or ID card?

Log on to the <u>CompTIA database</u> to request a new certificate and ID card. There is a \$15 replacement fee.

If you have not logged on to this site before there is a link on the right for first time users. You will need your score report once you have logged on. Once you are in the database and have updated your demographic information, click on the *Request Certificate* link and fill out the request form.

The CompTIA Linux+ exam is available to CompTIA corporate members for \$155 USD and to non-members for \$207 USD. Check with your employer - if your company is a member, you qualify for the discounted price. Look up exam prices.

When will I receive my certificate and ID card?

You will receive your certificate and ID card within 4 - 6 weeks of passing your exam. Contact CompTIA if you have not received your materials after 8 weeks. Include your name, address, phone number and ID number.
